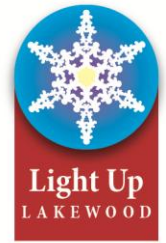

Light Up Lakewood Festival Royalty Scholarship Application

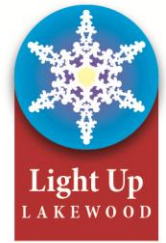

Interviews of the finalists will be held prior to Thanksgiving at a date yet to be determined.

By completing this application the applicant agrees to the following, if awarded the scholarship:

- Scholarship winners shall attend a Light Up Lakewood award ceremony during the afternoon of December 7, 2019 at Plantation Home and attend the Light Up Lakewood event from 4-8 p.m. that day while also participating in the parade and lighting ceremony.
- Scholarship winners agree to dedicate 20 hours of volunteer community service for a non-profit(s) of their choice between December 2019 and December 2020.
 - A portion (or all) of the hours can be completed by volunteering at LakewoodAlive's 2020 events: Lakewood Summer Meltdown (July 11, 2020), Spooky Pooch Parade (October 17, 2020) and Light Up Lakewood (December 5, 2020) as well as our Housing Outreach volunteer projects from April-November.
- Scholarship winners will make every effort to attend the 2020 Light Up Lakewood Royalty ceremony to help pass the title to that year's recipients.
